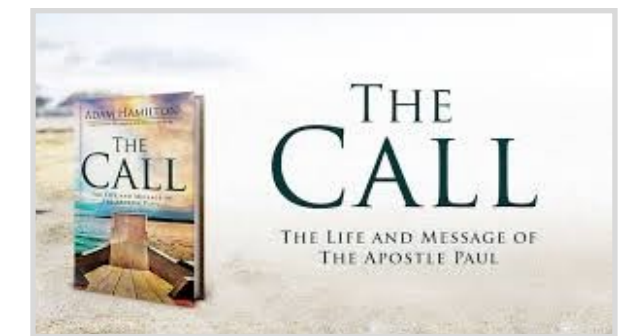
The Souper Bowl results are in. FUMC of Jupiter-Tequesta predicted the Super Bowl winning team yet again.
