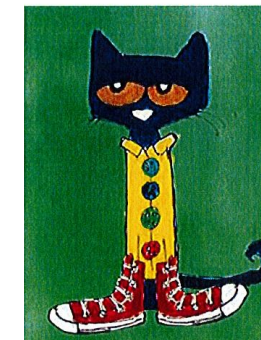
## **STOP HUNGER NOW**

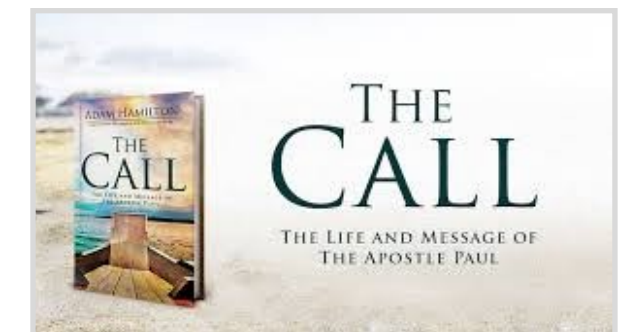
